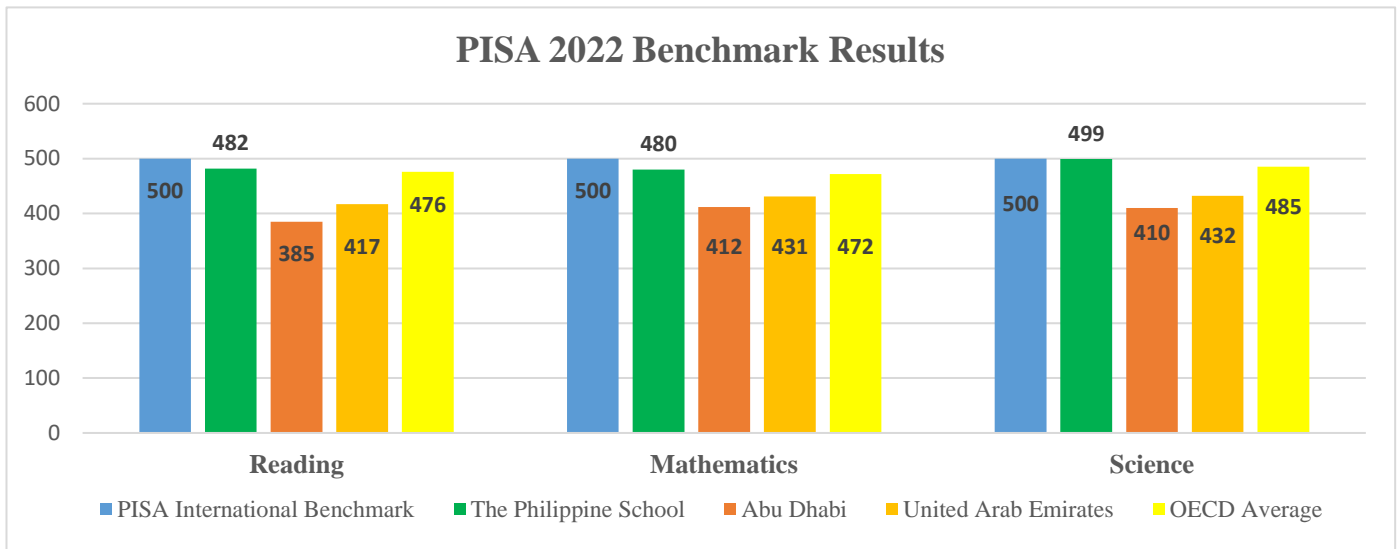




Programme for International Student Assessment (PISA) Analysis and Interpretation of PISA 2022



Overview:

PISA is an international test that measures 15-year-old students' abilities in Reading, Mathematics, and Science. Conducted every three years by the OECD, it evaluates how well education systems prepare students for real-life situations. The results guide education policies and help improve learning outcomes globally.

Analysis and Interpretation of PISA 2022:

The data compares the performance of The Philippine School Abu Dhabi, PISA International Benchmark, National Average (Abu Dhabi and United Arab Emirates) and OECD average overall in different subjects (Math, Science, and Reading) in the PISA 2022.

The Philippine School Abu Dhabi shows strong performance across all subjects, with scores of 482 in **Reading**, 480 in **Mathematics**, and 499 in **Science**. While these scores are above the OECD, Abu Dhabi, and UAE averages, they fall slightly short of the PISA international benchmark of 500 in **Reading** and **Mathematics**. The school's performance in **Science** is close to meeting the benchmark, highlighting strong science education, while **Reading** and **Mathematics** show small gaps that could be addressed through targeted improvements in curriculum and teaching methods to better align with international standards. Looking ahead, TPS AUH has set a PISA 2025 target of 501 in Reading, 511 in Mathematics, and 519 in Science, aiming for further academic growth and alignment with international benchmarks.
